President, Tom Halstead called the March 2004 meeting to order at 7:32PM. The minutes from the 29 January 2004 meeting were read and approved by the board.

Treasurer's Report: Linda Harrison provided copies of the treasurer's report for everyone. The report covered the time period from 1 January 2004 to 16 March 2004. The report was as follows:

Linda informed the executive board that SEVYSA was filing income taxes for the first time this year, as over \$25,000.00 was received for services in the tax year. Linda verified all executive board members names and addresses for this income tax report.

VYSA: Denise reported that the state association is expected to provide central coordination for an expanded joint league effort modeled after the SEVYSA / RMYSL collaboration. The four leagues involved are expected to be SEVYSA, RMYSL, BRCL, and ODSL. This effort is expected to win the approval of the VYSA board on 17 March 2004. Rules and procedures would then be formulated and provided to the participating leagues. This effort is thought to include U-13 and above and is expected to provide a more competitive environment in the long run. A motion was passed by acclamation authorizing a positive vote on this issue by the SEVYSA representative at the VYSA meeting.

Administrator: Team and club packets for the upcoming spring season were provided to all club representatives in exchange for the payment of their leagues fees. It was noted that the packets did not include the schedules which will be posted to the league website. It was also noted that updates would be made to the club directories.

New Business: There were several individual and team waivers for the spring season, which were approved by the board as summarized herein.

- The CSSC Crew U-10 was approved for continued participation from the fall with 7 U-9 players and 4 U-10 players. It was noted that while this team had failed to meet league requirements in the fall that it would have to be brought into compliance for the fall of 2004. The vote was Yes (10) and No (3).
- VA Rush Classic Black U-10 waiver for Michael Abraham (U-8) to play up 2 years. This team has only one other underage player. Unanimously approved.
- Baystars Force U-10 waiver for Kyle Rowe (U-8) to play up 2 years. Unanimously approved.
- Williamsburg United U-14 to use a league roster to add a U-15 player, Garrett Majdic, while participating in the U-14 A division. It was clarified that U-15 players could not play in the U-14IL division. Unanimously approved.

It was announced that two U-12 teams had disbanded, Norfolk United and VA Rush Penn Classic Rapids. The use of a league roster was discussed in allowing more than three players to play with other teams this spring. The CSL representative distributed copies of a letter from their league president to SEVYSA. This letter acknowledged the excellent sportsmanship displayed by the VA Rush Classic Black U-17 team in presenting the division winner award shirts to the CSL United U-17 team. The CSL U-17 team was unable to play all of its matches in the fall and thus finished second even though it had defeated this Rush team. It was in recognition of this situation that the Rush team decided to present the award shirts to the CSL U-17 team. It was approved by proclamation to present a second set of division winner award shirts for this division to this Rush Classic U-17 team. It was noted that there might well have been other teams from the fall that found them in the same situation as the CSL United U-17 but were not fortunate enough to have opponents like the Rush Classic U-17 team.
