**Call to Order:**

President, Tom Halstead at 7:38PM, called the April SEVYSA board meeting to order. The following member clubs were represented: Atlantic, Baystars, Beach FC, BRUSC, CFC, and CSSC.

**Reports:**

Dennis Blackmore, Beach FC questioned the roster size of the U12 age level. It was confirmed that an 18-player roster would be allowed for U12 teams. The minutes of the 26 March 2002 meeting were read and approved.

**VYSA:**

Drew Finley attended the monthly VYSA meeting in Richmond on 17 April 2002. Drew reported that SEVYSA has \$649.00 in JCP credits. The VYSA board approved a proposal by Gordon Miller that starting 1 September 2002 coaches must complete the "E" course before being accepted to a "D" course. The exception to this would be college coaching experience or higher. Outstanding tournament reports are due from the ERSC Blizzard Bash, Jan-Feb 2002, and the Newport News Aztec Indoor, Feb 2002. VYSA is revising the Kid Safe program with information in a new manual. VYSA board meetings are open to the public. If anyone is interested in attending please contact Drew for the dates and times.

**Rules & Discipline:**

There have been several inquiries about yellow/red cards and their point values from member clubs. Please refer to the SEVYSA procedures manual for a reminder on how the points add up. It is up to the individual managers to keep track of their players' individual penalty points.

At present the league has no restrictions and a player can be released anytime at his own request. Tom Halstead noted that HRGSA has adopted a policy that players cannot change teams during a playing season unless specifically approved by the HRGSA Board.
