Treasurer's Report: Copies of the treasurer's report were provided as follows:

Income:	\$32,053.00
Expenses:	\$15,621.23

VYSA: VYSA fees will increase this fall, SEVYSA fees will not increase its fees until Fall 2005.

The Articles of Incorporation for SEVYSA were reviewed by an attorney and changes will be made.

Administrator: Problems have been experienced with the Youth Leagues program. Tom Halstead's business is capable of handling the program as well as making more information available; Denise recommended dropping Youth Leagues and hiring TBI. The motion was approved.

A Guest Player Proposal was distributed to be taken back to clubs for discussion. This would be for SEVYSA league games only, not IL games or SEVYSA tournaments. This is proposed to alleviate shortages due to injuries, vacations, etc. and player development.

Dennis Blackmore with Beach FC requested a waiver for the U10C team to consist of (6) U9 players and (4) U10 players. The waiver was approved unanimously.
