President, Tom Halstead called the June 2004 SEVYSA meeting to order at 7:32PM. The minutes from the 18 May 2004 were read and approved by the board.

Treasurer's Report: The treasurer, Linda Harrison had copies of the treasurer's report available for everyone. The report covered the time period from 1 January 2004 to 15 June 2004. Linda also reported the SEVYSA income taxes are still being completed. The report was as follows:

VYSA Report: There does not appear to be support on the VYSA board for the sponsoring of a statewide premier league and thus SEVYSA will continue to work with other interested leagues to offer inter-league divisions. It is presently not known if SEVYSA's contribution to the IL divisions will be 2,4, or 6 teams per age group. The state has adopted a new format for assigning team numbers and this format will be presented at the July meeting. The number of allowed transfer players on a roster is being increased to five.

Administrator's Report: The spring division award T-shirts should be available at the July meeting but there are still some missing match reports, which need to be submitted.

Old Business: A proposal was presented to formalize the practice of the winning team moving up one division for the next playing season with the last place team moving down one division. This practice is expected to become mandatory with the right of appeal. It was suggested that a provision be added to address the withdrawal of teams from divisions after approval of the divisions by the board. This provision would call for review by the competition chair whenever two or more teams are withdrawn from any division. The finalized proposal will be presented for a vote at the July meeting.

The draft of the league guest player rule was discussed and marked up for revision. The revised draft will be posted on the league website and will be voted on at the July meeting. Most of the discussion involved the allowed number of guest players for a match and the use of guest players from affiliated clubs.

President Halstead reported that Charles Silverman will not be continuing as Competition Chairman nor will Mike McNish continue to serve as the SEVYSA League Registrar.

New Business: Tidewater Soccer Club fielded only one team this spring and was advised by President Halstead that they would be required to field at least two teams for the fall season in accordance with league rules. RMYSL has restricted its U-10 and U-11 divisions to Richmond only in view of travel requirements for younger players. Several outlying clubs are now looking for places for their U-10 and U-11 teams to play. Colonial Heights has approached SEVYSA. It was stated that any clubs looking to bring these younger teams into the league would have to agree to our small-sided format at these ages.

President Tom Halstead, adjourned the meeting at 9:32PM.
