President Tom Halstead called the June SEVYSA meeting to order at 7:37 p.m. Minutes from the last meeting were approved.

Treasurer's report:

- A report for income and expenses from January 2003 through June 24, 2003 were available.

- By-law amendment - A league will be in bad standing if fees are not paid by the deadline. (Accurate player counts from registrars are needed on a timely basis.)

Administrator report:

- Standings for the spring season were distributed along with listings of games either not played or scores not submitted.

Old Business:

- Minimum team manager duties:
 - An outline of team manager duties/responsibilities was made available
 - It was stressed that managers need to communicate with opposing team manager at least 24 hours in advance confirming game time, location, etc.Take nothing for granted!
- Denise Edwards offered to do a manager orientation on a Saturday at the end of July discussing rules, procedures, etc. Clubs were asked to reply to Tom Halstead by Friday, June 27th with a count of managers interested.
- Team numbers are in the SEVYSA manual, any questions contact your registrar.

New Business:

- Fall 2003 calendar was distributed with the following changes:
 - Competition meeting will be Sunday August 3rd, one individual per club at the competition meeting, Haygood Sew n' Vac, Virginia Beach.
 - November 9th was changed to a tournament weekend / Rain-out date.
 - Rain date could be November 9th if both teams are not in a tournament and it would not be a one game per field situation. Only other rain date would be December 14th (December 7th is a tournament date)
 - The season will be nine game dates, one being a double-header.

- Mike McNish was approved as the new league registrar. The President asked all members to be aware that a by-law amendment will be proposed to remove assistant league registrars from the Board of Directors. Dawn Krause of CSSC was approved as the registrar for CSSC, ERSC and Churchland.

- SEVYSA will again place an ad in the William & Mary yearbook at the cost of \$160 to \$200.

- Free web hosting is available for clubs; the only cost is a \$20 domain registration fee. Interested clubs should contact Tom Halstead.

- On-line game reporting normally costs \$5,000 and up. SEVYSA may test a program next spring; however score cards will still need to be mailed.

- Proposed By-law changes will be made available before the August 5 meeting.
- Available to all clubs was a CD containing RosterPro 2003, the VYSA 2003 manual and the SEVYSA 2003 manual. This CD can be copied.
- Carver Fisher, a U9 player on the Baystars FC Lasers, was approved to play U11.
- It was stressed that all special circumstance requests be made before the competition meeting.
- Our meeting place at Riverside will be moved in the fall due to construction, we will be at the opposite end of the hospital. If you can't find the meeting, find security and ask where the SEVYSA meeting is being held.
- Kidsafe matters were discussed. After August 31st your club will pay a fee of no more than \$10 for each new background check. These background checks must be done on each coach, assistant coach, team manager and team volunteer that is on the official roster and must be completed by September 1st. Upon completion, Tom Halstead must be notified. Background checks are valid for a five year period. In order to take advantage of the first year "deal" offered by the background check supplier please check all of your new people before September 1, 2003.
- The next SEVYSA meeting will be July 8, 2003 at 7:30 p.m. at Riverside Hospital. Team declarations are due at this meeting, as well as \$100 per team, administrative and field declarations (including maps if the field was not previously declared).

The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 p.m.
