President, Tom Halstead called the July SEVYSA meeting to order at 7:32PM. The minutes from the 24 June 2003 were read and approved after one correction. The correction was that the team representative for the Soccer Club of Northern Neck is Chris Malo and Larry Monaco is the SEVYSA Rules & Discipline chairman.

**Treasurer's Report:** Linda Harrison had copies of the treasurer's report available for everyone. The report covered the time period from 1 January 2003 to 8 July 2003. The report follows:

There is a total of approximately \$41,000.00 in the SEVYSA checking account, which is too large a surplus to carry in order to keep the status of a tax-free non-profit organization. It was discussed that a reserved working amount should be left at \$10,000-\$12,000. SEVYSA will reduce, for the fall season, the administrative costs per team from \$115.00 to \$100.00. Al Cousineau made a motion, and Tom Banford seconded to reduce the carding fees per team to 15 players for an 18-person roster, and 12 players for a fourteen-person roster. The motion was passed unanimously. This cost will be included in the team fees for each team. The total amounts due from each team will be available upon the results of the competition meeting.

**Registrar:**

Mike McNish was introduced as the new SEVYSA League Registrar. There are also five assistant registrars in the SEVYSA playing area. The training for the two new registrars, Raelynn Berry and Dawn Krause, will begin at the end of July. The player registration cards were made available for all the team representatives to pick up for their clubs.

**Administrator:**

Denise Edwards collected all the team competition and administrative declaration forms. The \$100 per team deposit was also collected with the team declarations. If you have any further information to turn in, please do so directly to Denise Edwards.

**Old Business:**

President Halstead advised that the proposed By-law change to remove the assistant league registrars from the league board of directors would be forwarded via email within two weeks. This proposal will then be voted on at the August meeting.

**New Business:**

President Halstead opened the floor to playing age waiver requests from the member clubs for the fall 2003 season. There were three clubs requesting waivers for teams being declared to play up one year but having a younger player already playing up one year on the team. Waivers of this nature had been requested to avoid confusion during the upcoming competition committee meeting. Approval of the waiver was not intended to intrude upon the actions of the competition committee. It was clarified that a waiver for a player to be allowed to play in a division two years older did only apply to players that would not have turned age 15 by 01 August 2003. Additionally, there was one waiver request for a player to play up two years. These four waivers were all approved and are listed as follows:

- ODSC: U-11 Force with player Zach Schaffer (U-10) declared to play in a U-12 division.
- NNFC: U-13 with player Brendan Avant (U-12) declared to play in a U-14 division.
- VA Rush: U-11 Nike with player Heath Saunders (U-10) to play in a U-12 division.
- Churchland SL: U-15 player Robert Black to play on a U-17 team.

NNFC also had two waiver requests for its U-10 "B" team. The first request was for a U-8 player, Kylie Barnett, to be allowed to play on this team. It was clarified that the team roster consisted of five U-10 players and five U-9 players with the team hence right at the 50% true age requirement for U-10 and U-11 teams. Thus, an additional waiver was required for the team to play with less than 50% true age. It was suggested that the club resolve the problem by moving players between its two U-10 teams. Al Cousineau, the club DOC, advised that the club desired to keep all the younger players on the same team so that in the future they could play on a team at their own age. These two waivers were approved by a vote of 13 yes and 2 no.
