Call to Order: President Tom Halstead called the meeting to order at 7:40 PM. The following member clubs were represented: Atlantic, Baystars FC, Beach FC, BRUSC, CSSC, Colonial FC, ERSC, Lafayette, Norfolk FC, ODSC, VBSC, VIP United, and WSC.

Reports:

Secretary: The minutes of the 24 June 2002 meeting were not available so President Halstead provided a brief summary as follows; Charlie Silverman was elected as the competition chairman and Linda Harrison as the treasurer. All other positions were filled by the incumbents. The U-12 field size was set at 50 by 90yds. The Nation's Capital Soccer League has inquired about possibly joining the IL division play. Their participation will be resolved prior to the upcoming competition committee meeting.

Administrator: League fees for the fall will be expanded to include both the player carding fees and the kid-safe fees. Member clubs will provide one check per club to cover all fees for their declared teams. This check will be due at the 24 27 August 2002 meeting at which time fall game schedules will be distributed. Only clubs, which pay their fees, will receive their schedules. It was reported that the state would like the team numbers and club numbers to match in the database. Hence, teams may be assigned new team numbers for the fall.

Competition: The fall competition committee meeting will be held on Sunday, 28 July 2002 at 1:15 PM in the Haygood Sew and Vac center located in the Haygood Shopping Center of Virginia Beach. Each member club should send only one representative.

Old Business: The nature of the officiating system for the 9 versus 9 play in the U-12 divisions remains to be established. A motion was made and passed to utilize a 3-man system for this age.

New Business: The team and club declarations and accompanying deposits were collected by the administrator. Field maps are due no later than the meeting of 30 July 2002. Final standings and penalty points are being loaded to the web. The statewide premier league is expected to play a winter and summer schedule. The importance of participating in the Blue Cross-Blue Shield substance abuse pledges was emphasized.

The next SEVYSA board meeting was announced for 30 July 2002 at 7:30 PM at Riverside Hospital. The meeting was adjourned at 8:15 PM.
