Location: Riverside Hospital

Call to Order: President, Tom Halstead, called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM. The following member clubs were represented: Atlantic, Baystars, BRUSC, CSSC, ERSC, Lafayette, NNUSC, ODSC, VIP United, and WSC.

Reports:

Secretary: The minutes of the 09 July 2002 meeting were amended to reflect that the league president, vice-president, and secretary retained their offices for another year. The amended minutes were then approved.

VYSA: It was reported that the statewide premier league should begin play this fall in late October. This league will have a new set of rules for travel within the state. It should be possible for players to participate in both their regular league and the new premier league. ODP tryouts for the southeast district were announced for August 3rd and 4th and the State Cup application deadline is August 23, 2002 for ages U-15 to U-18.

Registrar: All the league registrars are getting very busy, with team registration packets, for early tournaments and State Cup play.

Administrator: Spring season division winner and sportsmanship shirts will be available at the August meeting. Denise collected field maps and directions for the upcoming season. The size of the U-12 field for nine-side play was verified as 50 yards by 90 yards.

New Business: The competition committee chairman presented the divisions, for the fall season. The Lafayette rep requested several changes be considered due to Lafayette not being represented at the competition committee meeting. President Halstead explained that changes could be made only if another club was willing to participate in the exchange or if the change was of overall benefit to the league.

A motion was made and approved to purchase a new computer for the league administrator for a cost not to exceed \$1,000.
