Sign In Sheet Meeting Date: 5 August 2003

Clubs/Members represented are as follows:

President, Tom Halstead called the August SEVYSA meeting to order at 7:33PM. The minutes from the 8 July 2003 were read and approved by the board.

Treasurer's Report: Linda Harrison had copies of the treasurer's report available for everyone. The report covered the time period from 1 January 2003 to 5 August 2003. The report was as follows:

VYSA Report: Tom Halstead had no report, as VYSA has not met since the last SEVYSA meeting. The next meeting is 20 August 2003. Fall 2003 State Cup Applications for the U18, U17, U16, and U15 age groups are now available on the VYSA website.

Competition Committee: Charles Silverman, the Competition Chairman had handouts for all the clubs with the proposed SEVYSA Fall 2003 Divisions and Fees. It was stated the monies due were based on a ten (10) game season, so the divisions with nine (9) games would be altered. These divisions are the U10A, U10B, U14A, and U17A divisions. Charles stated that the Competition meeting was well organized with a couple of little exceptions. There were a number of teams declared in the wrong age group, and several teams omitted their club names. Charles suggested that the declaration forms include team name beginning next spring season. It was also pointed out that a younger team was playing up in an IL division this fall. There are sometimes exceptions, and this team met all the criteria necessary to play up one year. A motion was made by Al Cousineau and seconded by Charles Silverman to accept the Proposed Divisions for the Fall 2003 season. The motion was voted on, and was unanimously approved by the board.

President's Report: Tom Halstead handed out Articles of Amendments under the State Corporation Commission that were prepared by Larry Monaco, SEVYSA R&D Chairman. These amendments are to be discussed with each of the clubs, with a vote planned for the next SEVYSA meeting on 26 August 2003. As a reminder to the club representatives it was stated that the U10 and U11 divisions play 7v7, U12 divisions play 9v9, and from U13 up play 11v11. A question was brought up regarding the U12 IL division, and Tom Halstead stated that is our verbal understanding that the U12's will play 9v9 both at home and in Richmond.

Administrator's Report: Denise Edwards ask that all clubs who had not submitted field declarations and current maps to do so immediately. Please send to her fax number, 588-3849. All field directions also need to go to Tom

Halstead for the website. Denise reminded clubs who had teams in the IL divisions that they need to provide one extra field for all IL games. The IL matches are played usually with two games playing at the same time side by side.

President, Tom Halstead, adjourned the August SEVYSA meeting at 7:56PM.
