**Reports:**

**Secretary:** The minutes of the 25 September 2001 meeting were read and approved.

**VYSA:** Clubs were advised that their directors and officers do not presently have liability insurance coverage from the state. VYSA is looking for ways to extend its coverage to these member clubs.

**Treasurer:** No report

**Rules & Discipline:** No report.

**Administrator:** Denise Edwards reported that there continues to be a problem with a shortage of referees, especially in the Richmond area. It is feasible that the clubs will need to provide linesmen for this coming weekend games for the IL in the Richmond area. Denise will further let the clubs know through email if the situation improves before the weekend. Clubs were reminded that referee courses are scheduled by the state and are listed on the VYSA website. The proposed spring 2002 calendar was distributed for review and approval at the next meeting. The team will be coached by Al Albert and will play at the William and Mary stadium. The roster can hold 26 players. Kevin Marston, the club representative for Colonial FC handed out flyers for the Colonial FC Indoor soccer leagues and Indoor tournaments.
