VYSA Report: No report. Tom stated that the monthly VYSA meeting is to be held on 17 November 2004.

Competition Chairman: The spring season will be comprised of eight matches. The proposed play dates are 4/03, 4/10, 4/17, 4/24, 5/01, 5/08, 5/15, and 5/22/05.

Rules and Discipline: Larry Monaco distributed a memorandum for the club representatives concerning various rules issues arising during this fall season. This memorandum covered numerous items such as uniforms, smoking at matches, protests, and the like. There have been several instances of teams failing to sit out players as required by the league rules covering penalty points. A motion was made and passed to enforce the match forfeiture rule relative to failure of a team to suspend players during the next match played. The vote was Yes (7), No (0), with 3 abstaining. It was noted that the guest player rule may affect player suspensions and that this matter requires clarification.

Registrar: No report.

Administrator: Denise Edwards reported that all match reschedules have been posted to the league website and that some matches have been scheduled for the weekend of December 11th and 12th.

Unfinished business: The suggestion from the October meeting that the league review its cumulative penalty-point sanctions was discussed. President Halstead suggested that the current accumulation of penalty points occurs as much from poor player behavior as from poor referee awareness of the level of play and SEVYSA rules. President Halstead suggested a meeting with both TSRA and PSOA officials prior to the upcoming season to clarify what SEVYSA wanted from its referee contractors, to go over the rules of competition and what SEVYSA will accept on the pitch.

Currently only 20 coaches have submitted their applications for the VYSA 2005 workshop to be held in February in Richmond. All clubs are requested to submit their completed coaches' applications (do not complete the means of payment area of the application) to Denise Edwards as soon as possible.

New business: VYSA will be hosting the Region One Championships from 30 June 2005 through 05 July 2005 in the Virginia Beach area with matches played at the Complex and Lake Taylor and ceremonies and showcase matches at the Sportsplex. SEVYSA hopes that all of its members will turn out to watch the Region 1 Championships in our area. VYSA will also be looking for event volunteers.
