VYSA Report: No Report. Drew Finley said to check the VYSA website for the dates of the annual VYSA awards. These awards will be presented at the January workshop in Crystal City, VA.

Competition Committee: No report. Tom Halstead did attend an Inter-league meeting on 26 November 2002 in Richmond. Both leagues agreed to stay with four teams per age group and not to allow teams to play down.

Rules & Discipline Committee: Alan Keck reported there would be a hearing tonight involving a U16 match. The incident under consideration happened on 3 November 2002 at TCC, Chesapeake involving a U16 CSSC United player and a U16 Atlantic Fusion player.

Registrar: No report.

Administrator: Denise reminded the registrars that she needed a total Fall 2002 count of registered players. This information is needed for VYSA membership and insurance purposes. Denise also reminded everyone to attend the **VYSA Workshop and Coaches Convention** on January 24, 25, 2003 at the Hyatt Regency in Crystal City in Arlington, Virginia. The SEVYSA division winner t-shirts and sportsmanship t-shirts were available and could be picked up immediately following the meeting.

Old Business:

U12 Format Discussion: The SEVYSA rules for the nine aside Under 12 age group were formalized as follows; Field size set at 50 yards by 90 yards with regulation goals. Officials will use a three-person system with substitutions to be made only with permission. It was also suggested that 10 yards be the rule for a free kick. RMYSL will be requested to use the nine-a-side format in Richmond for the spring season. It was also mentioned that the U12 matches that are considered home games, may not be played on their teams' own fields. Due to scheduling a "common field" may be used for some of the U12 matches.

Other: The question of allowing the use of league guest players was tabled for discussion in January. Member clubs were reminded of the requirement to certify completion of criminal background checks. This certification should be provided to Tom Halstead, the league president as soon as possible. Clubs failing to perform and notify the President of their performance of the VYSA criminal background checks will not be eligible to play in spring 2003.

New Business:

The spring calendar was adopted. It provides for ten play dates starting on March 16th and concluding on May 18th. There will be no matches on Easter weekend.

The next SEVYSA meeting is scheduled for 7 January 2003, 7:30PM at Riverside Hospital. At this meeting all club representatives must submit their Spring 2003 Competition forms, and Declaration forms. In addition the deposit checks of \$100 per team are due. Each club should submit only one check payable to SEVYSA for their total number of teams times the \$100.00. The field declaration forms and current maps are also due to Denise at this time.
